Please join us to view a cost-effective alternative in flexible pavement rehabilitation in Raleigh, NC. The existing roadway is being reclaimed and strengthened through a process known as Full-Depth Reclamation (FDR) using cement. The project specifications consist of reclaiming the existing asphalt roadway to remove excess material and then blending the failed surface into the existing base while adding Portland cement. This process will create a strong, less permeable base that will strengthen the roadway service life. FDR is being used more and more by municipal, county and state road departments, as well as airports throughout the southeast as a problem solving alternative to patching, pothole repair, cumbersome reconstruction or maintenance of a problematic roadway.
